**** swimmers will only be permitted to swim one of the 400/800/1500 free. These events may be swum 2 per lane as needed and may be limited to the number of heats depending on time restraints.****

ENTRY FEES: \$10.00 PER SWIM. Please bring payment to the meet. Payment must be received prior to the start of warm up.

PROCEDURES: The events file for Hy-Tek Team Manager will be available on the www.swimming.ca website. All entries must be received via swimming.ca. Manual entries will not be accepted. PLEASE, confirm your attendance ASAP, to avoid disappointment. All results will be posted on the BRANT website and on www.swimming.ca

RULES:

- Only swimmers, certified coaches, officials and authorized person are allowed on deck (or designated area).
- All events are time finals and will be senior seeded swum mixed fastest to slowest.
- The meet will be seeded as long course only, converted times will not be used.
- Results will be broken into the following age categories, 10&under, 11&12, 13&14, 15&over.
- The meet is time final events only.
- There are no qualifying standards for entry to the meet.
- This is not an IPC sanctioned event.
- The FINA start rule is in effect.
- Please note Swimming Canada Competition Warm-up Safety Procedures will be in effect. Swimmers witnessed by a Safety Marshall diving or entering the water in a dangerous fashion may be removed without warning from their first individual event following the warm-up period in which the violation occurred. - Meet Officials will provide a safe environment and an organized competition. We are not responsible for the supervision of the athletes during the competition and especially, during session breaks.

- Coaches are responsible for their swimmers' conduct and knowledge of the Safety Procedure Rules.
- **GLASS CONTAINERS** are strictly prohibited from the deck area as are outdoor footwear.
- Shoe coverlets will be provided if necessary.
- Only FINA approved swimwear is allowed in the competition as per GR 5. The full details can be viewed [HERE](#).

OFFICIAL SPLITS: Meet management requires that any coach wishing to rely on a time achieved by the swimmer for an interval shorter than the total distance of the event shall so advise the Referee prior to the commencement of the session (or event) in question.

AWARDS/SCORING: There will be no scoring or awards for this meet.

SCRATCH RULE: A simple NS at the event is permitted and there will be no penalty imposed.

RESULTS: Will be posted to the Swimming Canada website within 2 days of completion of the meet.

SNC LTAD:

- All events will be swum age and sex combined.
- No session will be longer than 4.5 hours in length

MIXED GENDER: The host seeks an exemption from the requirement to swim events in gender separated events due to facility or time limitations, swimming separated by gender would not permit all swims to be completed while offering reasonable opportunities to swim for all participants, and in particular on an equitable basis for swimmers of each gender.

VIDEO/PHOTOGRAPHY: In accordance with Swim Ontario's risk management Policies, the promoters of this event require that any person wishing to engage in any video, zoom or close range photography requiring deck access are to obtain authorization from meet management before the start of the meet.

COACH'S REGISTRATION:

Meet management will cross reference the list of coaches in attendance at this competition with the [Swim Ontario Compliancy lists](#). If a coach is not on this list, meet management is obligated to enforce the SNC policy and not permit that coach to attend meet. Meet management will forward Swim Ontario a list of coaches who they have found to be in non-compliance.

OUT OF PROVINCE CLUBS:

All Clubs from outside of Ontario must provide a "Certificate of Insurance" naming the "City of Brantford" and the "Brantford Aquatic Club" as insured parties. This must be received 7 days prior to meet. No Clubs will swim without proof of insurance. All Clubs must be FINA affiliated and provide swimmer registration numbers with entries. All swimmers and coaches must have primary residence within the province /state or country for which they claim registration. Proof of residency may be green card, student ID, driver's license, college residence or other document as deemed acceptable by Swim Ontario and shall be submitted with the [Proof of Residence and Registration Status form](#) to Swim Ontario no later than 7 days prior to start of competition.
